A Moore Bros. white glazed porcelain timepiece, circa 1870, modelled as two cherubs flanking a spherical drum housing the timepiece and applied with cactus flowers, impressed and incised marks to base, height 24cm, together with a pair of Mintons white glazed figural spill holders (faults).

Estimate: £100 - £150

Condition Report

1426. Clock - fine crazing overall. Two significant haircracks to base and a number of smaller haircracks to body overall, e.g. radiating from mounting of clock face. One cherub missing index finger. Minton gentleman - crazed. Number of haircracks to body overall, e.g. right side of gentleman's waist, elbow of left arm, number to base. Minton lady - some crazing. Haircrack to left wrist, across hem of skirt, basket of skirt and to spill holders.
