## LOT 1466

A C.H. Brannam Barum pottery green glazed owl jug, height 16.5cm, four other pottery owl jugs and a collection of similar pottery, including a yellow glazed two handled jardinière and saucer, made for Liberty London, a Carter Stabler Adams Poole pottery green glazed jardinière, and motto ware (faults).

## Condition Report

1466. Glazes typically crazed overall. Smallest owl jug - chip to beak and edge of foot, minor frits to rim. Second smallest owl jug - handle broken in 4 places and glued, some frits. Green Brannam owl - number of chips to foot and rim, fritting overall. Blue owl jug - minor fritting, generally ok. Tiny blue owl - considerable chips and fritting. Motto ware stand - chipped. Blue gull jug - chip to spout. Onion necked vase - haircrack to rim. Ochre Liberty bowl - hairline to rim, large glaze frit to side and to base interior. The Liberty stand has a large chip to the rim and a haircrack. Blue owl bowl - fritted chipping to rim and beaks, surface scratches. Green Poole bowl - glaze chip to edge of foot. Exeter polychrome owl - haircrack to rim. Small floral vase - chip to rim. Crocus vase - large chip and 2 smaller to apertures. Green motto jug - fritting to rim and handle. Aller Vale face jug - fritting. Tyg - chips to rim. Large floral vase - fritted chips to foot, other glaze loss and minor haircrack to neck. Brannam hors-d'oeuvre - chips to rim. Squashed cream glazed jug - chips to rim. Longpark small crocus - chips to 2 apertures. Green owl vase - chips and extensive fritting.
