A collection of decorative ceramics, 20th century, including a Royal Doulton deep blue glazed shallow circular bowl with trailed decoration to rim, printed factory mark to base, diameter 15cm, a mottled blue glazed vase of squat form with indented roundel decoration to shoulders, height 9cm, and various other vases (some faults).

Condition Report

1492. Blue Doulton bowl - small chip and crack to top rim edge, surface scratches. Bulbous blue vase with prunts, cross to base - minor fritting to rim and surface wear. Rye vase - small burst air bubble to glaze on interior rim with associated short haircrack. Small frill rim jardiniere - unmarked, minute nick to rim. Green cosy teapot - surface scratches/wear to widest part of body. Crazed. Cover stained with small haircrack to corner. Two handled turquoise glazed vase - small chip to rim. Bellarmine style jug - unmarked, chipping to footrim, chip to eyebrow. Bretby orange and yellow pot - small chip to rim. Stapleton brown mottled glaze vase - chip to rim. Decoro vase - small nick and haircrack to rim. Small Wedgwood vase - small haircrack and glazed over manufacturers chip to rim. Marbled vase - unmarked, cracked. Wilkinson tea plate - surface wear/scratches. Paragon Rainbow lustre bowl - nick to rim, some wear. Blue and white tea bowl - unmarked, rim extensively chipped. Remaining items generally ok.
