A collection of mostly English porcelain teawares, including a Spode cup and saucer, circa 1820, decorated in the Imari palette with flowers, red painted 'Spode 3573' to base of cup, saucer diameter 14.2cm, and a Copeland cup and saucer painted with panels of exotic birds against a pink and gilt ground.

Condition Report

1502. Spode 3573 - minor filled chip to rim of cup. Gold ground rose decorated - unmarked. No chips, cracks or repairs. Copeland pink ground D8795 - minor hairline to rim of saucer, wear to gilding on rim of cup and side of handle. Unmarked floral trio - light wear to gilt rim of saucer and light surface scratches. Teacup crazed with minor staining to firing crack on handle. Coffee cup ok. Paris pink ground rams head handle - unmarked, good condition, no chips, cracks or repairs. Pair cups and saucers pattern number C8569 - crazing to turquoise ground of one saucer, otherwise ok, no chips, cracks or repairs.
