A Japanese Shibayama inlaid and lacquered ivory folding fan, Meiji period, the pair of guards finely worked in gilt lacquer and inlaid in mother-of-pearl and various hardstones with birds and insects amidst peach branches and bamboo, the eighteen sticks with similarly lacquered decoration to both sides, length 40.5cm (some losses).

1019. Overall fairly good condition. Ivory sticks and guards in good condition. Both guards are missing some inlay, one is missing a bird and insect; the other a bird and two fruit. Otherwise inlay and lacquer in good order. Lacquer on sticks in good order. Later replacement panel.
