A Victorian 18ct gold and diamond ring, designed as two entwined serpents with rose cut diamond set eyes, Birmingham 1869, ring size approx M.

Condition Report

503. The diamonds slightly draw colour and have one or two chips. The mount is in good condition with only a few surface marks mainly to the back of the shank. There is a file mark to the front of one of the snake's head. One of the diamonds has a black piqué inclusion. Weight 10.4g.

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
