A gold and enamel mounted navette shaped mourning pendant, glazed with a panel depicting a lady standing beside a plinth with two doves and a cherub above a blue and white enamel border, length 5.7cm, and a gold mounted seed pearl curved rectangular brooch, glazed with a locket compartment to the centre within a border of seed pearls, width 2.5cm.

Condition Report

562. Mourning pendant: the pendant is overall rather dirty. There is a chip to the top of the glass and some chipping and wear to the enamelled surround. There is a repair below the suspension at the back and one or two surface dents to the back. Weight 10.3g. Brooch: the half-pearls are a little grey with one or two starting to peel. There is a repair to the hinge pin at the back. Both pieces would benefit from careful professional cleaning. Weight 5.3g.
