590. The beads to the monogram have broken away and are loose beneath the glazed covering. The white enamel is in good condition for its age. There is no inscription beneath the bezel. In overall good condition. The case is a little scuffed to the exterior. Weight 6.4g. Head size 3cm x 1.7cm.

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
