A diamond, half-pearl and blue enameled circular brooch, circa 1900, mounted with the principal cushion shaped diamond within a surround of nine rose cut diamonds, on a blue enameled ground within a border of half-pearls, diameter 2.5cm.

Estimate: £100 - £150

Condition Report

629. There is some chipping to the edge of the blue enamel. The diamonds slightly draw colour with one or two internal inclusions. The brooch pin fitting is a later alteration. There is some scratching and scratched code marks visible to the back. The original suspension loop is missing. This is likely to be a pendant converted for wear as a brooch. Plain back in good condition. Weight 7.8g.

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
