A Benzie of Cowes gold, reverse painted intaglio crystal and white enameled scarf slide, circa 1924, the intaglio crystal designed as the racing flag of the Royal Cutter Yacht HMY Britannia, beloved by King George V, which was sunk at St Catherine's Deep after his death, detailed to the underside '18ct Benzie Cowes', width 4.5cm, with the original fitted case.
