A Japanese Satsuma earthenware circular bowl by Ryokuzan, Meiji period, the interior finely painted and gilt with a lakeside scene of women and children with pavilions and mount Fuji beyond, within a wide border of simulated brocade in a trellis design, the exterior gilt with flowers, foliage and mon beneath a key fret rim, on a dark blue ground, black and gilt censer mark incorporating signature to base, height 8.5cm, diameter 18.5cm.

Condition Report

1164. In good condition overall, no chips, cracks or repairs. Fine crazing to glaze predominantly visible to blue ground exterior. Enamels and gilding generally good, some typical wear and minor losses to heavy gilded detail of exterior primarily.
