A Japanese Satsuma earthenware koro by Hankinzan, Meiji period, the squat circular body painted and gilt with butterflies and millefleurs beneath a red keyfret band and simulated brocade rim and upright handles, raised on similarly decorated tripod scroll legs, gilt signature seal mark to base, height 11.2cm (minor restoration), together with a hardwood cover.

Condition Report

1103. Both handles have been broken and restored, not immediately noticeable but evident under close inspection. Minor wear to gilt. Typical light crazing. Otherwise body and legs in good condition. Replacement wood cover.
