A Chinese famille rose export porcelain large circular dish, Yongzheng period, the centre finely painted with the goddess Xiwangmu holding a lingzhi in her right hand, accompanied by a deer holding two peaches in its mouth and an attendant boy, all beneath a prunus branch, the rim filled with sprays of peony and magnolia, diameter 39cm (restoration).

Estimate: £1,500 - £2,500

Condition Report

1066. Section of rim between 10 and 11 o'clock broken away in 2 pieces and visibly restored (approx 15cm x 5.5cm). Two cracks to rim at 2 and 7 o'clock (approx 10cm long), both with some minor retouching. Typical light surface wear/scratches to enamels.
