A Chinese blue and white porcelain vase, Kangxi period, the baluster body painted with figures in a mountainous coastal landscape, height 27cm (reduced neck and repaired), together with a pair of Chinese famille rose porcelain vases, late 19th century, painted with figures, height 24.5cm (converted to table lamps and faults), a Chinese Transitional style wucai porcelain vase, height 26.5cm (reduced neck), an export porcelain bowl and a blue and white coffee cup and saucer (faults).

Condition Report

1083. Blue and white vase - reduced neck, top half of the body broken into numerous pieces, repaired with some filler and overpainting. Drilled hole to base and star crack across base. Wucai vase - reduced neck, otherwise body in good condition with no cracks or repairs. Pair of famille rose vases converted to lamps - one in good condition with only small chip to rim, otherwise body is in good order. The other vase has been broken into four or five pieces and re-glued with some filler. Neck is cracked and one third of rim is broken and missing. Famille rose bowl - section of rim broken out and re-glued, otherwise ok. Blue and white cup - good condition. Saucer - cracked.
