A small group of Meissen porcelain teawares, late 19th/early 20th century, painted with scattered floral sprigs, comprising a small coffee pot and cover, milk jug, four coffee cups and five saucers, crossed swords in underglaze blue to bases (faults), together with a small group of other Continental porcelain (faults).

Condition Report

1430. Meissen teawares - coffee pot lid with crudely restored finial, coffee pot has chip to underside of inner rim edge, otherwise ok. One cup chipped, another with chip to rim and associated hairline, another hairline cracked. One saucer with chip to rim. Other Meissen pieces ok. Pink roses part service - coffee pot lid chipped, milk jug with chip to rim, one saucer rivet repaired. Berlin pot and cover - visibly restored cover. Nymphenberg cups and saucers - all ok. Other items all ok.
