Condition Report

Overall light browning. Some fading with associated loss and muting of colour, particularly evident in the sky. Considerable detritus trapped between glass and picture much of which is adhered to the underside of the glass. It is difficult to establish how much of this, if any, has transferred to the work, inevitably some might have and if so, there may be light staining beneath. Because of the considerable dirt to the underside of the glass it is difficult to see if any foxing or spotting is present, if it is it would only be very pale and slight as there is nothing prominent. The mount and backing do not appear to be archival. The work has slipped slightly in the mount. The frame is in generally good condition but some chipping and loss is present to the extremities. Unexamined out of the frame.
