A group of five pieces of Locke & Co Worcester porcelain, late 19th/early 20th century, comprising a pair of hexagonal dishes, each painted with a peacock, signed H. Wall, width 12.3cm, a pair of vases, painted with a goldfinch, and a potpourri dish with pierced and leaf moulded rim, printed marks to bases.

Estimate: £60 - £100

Condition Report

1485. Hexagonal dishes - typical light wear to high points and bases, one with small dirt spotting in glaze from manufacturing process on base only, otherwise both ok. Vases - one vase with a couple of minute nibbles to high edges of rim, some light surface wear to both, otherwise ok. Pot pourri dish - in good condition, no chips, cracks or repairs.
