A set of late 19th/early 20th century brass curtain tracks, the reeded poles hung with floral swag mounts and fitted with shaped finials, together with a similar brass bed canopy mount.

Condition Report

2594. There are five lengths of track, two of which have a pulley system inset into the top of the rail. Some can clearly fit together and please note the two differing designs of finials. All the swags are present but a few of the rose mounts are missing. Lengths 155cm, 155cm, 160cm, 140cm and 140cm. No wall brackets and general condition is ok but just needs work to make them useable. Width of bed canopy 68cm.

2594. Three sections are 149cm long and two sections are 135cm.
