A Japanese cloisonné small circular dish, unsigned but possibly by Namikawa Yasuyuki, Meiji period, finely worked with five butterflies within a surround of various chrysanthemums and leaves on a black ground, the pale brown underside with flowers, leaves and tendrils, unsigned, diameter 7.2cm.

Condition Report

1099. Small filled area to centre of upper surface - please use the zoom feature on our website to view the image and this can be seen. The surface also has an overall pitted appearance and some scratches - again visible via our website. This pitted appearance extends to small pinpoint sized holes among the flowers and to the edge - predominantly to the upper surface and less so to the underside.
