A pair of Japanese Satsuma earthenware vases, Meiji period, of shouldered tapering form, the body painted and gilt with opposing panels of samurai, and women with children, reserved against a simulated brocade ground, gilt signature to bases, height 24.5cm, together with a smaller Satsuma vase, painted with opposing figural panels against a blue and gilt ground, height 15.5cm.
