A Meissen porcelain figure group, late 19th century, modelled as five child musicians upon a naturalistic rocky base, crossed swords in underglaze blue and incised '2489' to base, height 16.5cm (restored). Provenance: from the estate of the late John Young (1927-2017).

Condition Report

1506. There is extensive restoration to this figure group, including to the head and both hands of conductor, with obvious discolouration and overspraying; to the right arm, hand and bow of child with yellow jacket, with some restoration and minor losses to the instrument; to the black flute held by the child in the pink jacket; to the left hand/arm and instrument held by the child in the green jacket, as well as to his right foot/leg; to the arms and instrument held by the child in blue, with small loss to the child's left foot.
