LOT 2110

A late 17th/early 18th century Continental laburnum oyster veneered collector's cabinet, the two doors and sides veneered with wide bands of shaped panels, the interior fitted with an arrangement of drawers and central cupboard, enclosing a mirrored niche compartment and pulling out to reveal a set of secret drawers, the later pine base raised on turned legs, height 146cm, width 91cm, depth 45cm (faults and alterations).

Estimate: £1,000 - £1,500

Condition Report

2110. Section of moulded trim missing to left side. Surface cracks and patches of veneer missing on sides and front. Particularly large cracks to doors. Interior in typically better condition, some handles missing and damaged to drawer fronts. Woodworm to top panel mostly at one end.
