## Condition Report

2001. The top does revolve. General condition of top and frieze is good with some minor restoration. There appears to be some filled holes around key escutcheons, there may have been a larger decorative escutcheon at some point. There is a crack to one leg which would need to be glue and clamped. Otherwise general condition is ok. The base appears to possibly be a bit later than the top, but if it is then it is a good match.
