A three row necklace of graduated spherical jade beads on a rectangular clasp, mounted with an oval jade panel, carved and pierced with floral decoration, length of shortest strand 35cm, diameter of largest jade bead 9mm, diameter of smallest jade bead 5mm, width of clasp 2.5cm.

Condition Report

541. The jade beads have variation of colour saturation and are not translucent. Some beads are more highly polished than others. The carved jade clasp has a central hairline internal fracture, although evident from the front it has not cracked through to both sides.
