## LOT 551

An oval moss agate and garnet ring, circa 1800, ring size approx P (two garnets lacking), part of a gem set ring, a foil backed flat cut garnet and cultured pearl pendant, probably Spanish or Portuguese, circa 1800, length 3.7cm, and a half-pearl small curved oval brooch, glazed with a woven hair locket compartment to the centre.

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## Condition Report

551. Moss agate and garnet ring - apart from two garnets lacking the garnets have slight variation of colour and one or two are chipped. The shank is split at the shoulders and looks to be composite to the ring, it is possibly a converted earring. Part of a gem ring - the back section of the shank is missing. There is evidence of lead solder to the shoulder joints. Garnet pendant - the pearl is starting to peel, this is probably not the original gem to the centre of the pendant and the lowest garnet is missing. There is some variation of cut and colour to the garnets. The bottom drop is lacking. Pearl oval brooch - this has been converted from a clasp. The glazed hair locket is cracked. The surrounding half-pearls are in good condition. The steel pin is perhaps replaced.

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
