A gold and diamond three stone ring, circa 1920, claw set with cushion shaped diamonds with the principal diamond mounted at the centre, detailed '18ct', ring size approx N1/2, total diamond weight approx 3.30-3.50ct.

Estimate: £4,000 - £6,000

Condition Report

600. The ring is in overall good condition with no significant damage and the diamonds are well matched stones. Centre stone - Carat: approx 1.70-1.80ct, it is a very nice bright white sparkly stone. Colour: difficult to grade the stone accurately without removing from setting and it is a little dirty under the mount. We are confident the colour is approx. G-H, but could be a touch better. Clarity: good clear stone with no obvious inclusions to the naked eye, approx. VS1-VS2. There are a few very minor nicks to the girdle. Outer stones - Carat: each approx. 0.70-0.80ct. Colour: well matched to the centre stone. Clarity: there are a few minor inclusions visible under magnification. One slightly more visible approx. SI1, the other approx. VS2. We would strongly recommend viewing this ring in person. Weight 5.4g.

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
