## Condition Report

1430. Meissen kingfisher - restored beak. Missing some applied foliage with old repair to the remainder. Worcester nightingale - restored beak, glued wing tip. Worcester wren - beak missing. Boehm chickadee - crack to base. Worcester goldcrest - nick to tip of beak. Worcester marsh tit - glued beak. German bird - chipped foliage. Volkstedt figure - missing pieces and repaired. Continental female figure - missing elements. 2 Continental owls - one with chipped foliage, other with glued repairs. Unmarked pottery bird - glued back to base. Faience bird - glued tail, chipped beak. Stan Laurel salt and Oliver Hardy pepper - both cracked and with small chips. Small pottery Laurel & Hardy - Hardy glued at neck. Two standing figures - necks cracked.
