A Swansea porcelain London shape Japan pattern teacup, circa 1820, iron red factory mark to base, together with a matched coffee cup and saucer, a New Hall trio, a Caughley trio, a Flight Barr & Barr cup and saucer and another trio, probably Grainger & Worcester.

Condition Report

1463. Swansea cup - in good condition, no chips, cracks or repairs. Matched coffee cup with small hairline crack to rim and small scratch to gilding on rim which allows you to see through the blue decoration beneath. Matched saucer in generally good condition, with some areas of crazing to underside. Noticeable wear to gilt decoration, particularly to the tree and inner border, some overall light surface scratching. Caughley trio - in generally good condition, all have some minor wear to the gilding on the high points, most noticeable on the saucer which also has some light surface scratching. New Hall trio - in generally good condition, the saucer has overall crazing and some minor wear to the gilding and floral decoration. Grainger & Worcester trio - in generally good condition, the saucer with some minor wear to the gilding and similarly to the high points on the cup.
