A Spode '967' Japan pattern part service, circa 1810, decorated in gilt overlaid Imari colours, comprising a two-handled sucrier and cover, a milk jug, a teapot stand, sixteen Bute shaped teacups, eleven coffee cans, sixteen saucers and four plates, printed pattern numbers to bases, diameter of plates 20.5cm (minor faults).

Estimate: £550 - £750

Condition Report

1492. Sucrier & cover - both cracked. Jug - finely crazed. Teapot stand - hairlines visible to underside. Teacups - 4 with minor hairlines, of the remainder 4 have significant loss to the green enamel detail. Coffee cups - 3 have significant losses to the green enamel detail, otherwise all ok. Saucers - 6 generally ok, 6 ok but with green enamel loss, 4 crazed and with loss to green enamel detail. Plates - one with short haircrack. Overall the gilding and enamels on the set remain bright and strong with no significant wear - apart from the green enamel losses detailed above.
