A Mason's Ironstone China 'Regency' pattern part service, including an oval platter, a sauce boat, two graduated rectangular stands, nine two-handled soup bowls, fifteen dinner plates, four salad plates, eleven side plates, twenty-seven cups, various saucers, a sugar bowl, an oval dish, four egg cups and a square dish, together with a small group of Mason's 'Strathmore' pattern dinner wares (minor faults).

Condition Report

1423. Regency pattern wares: Both graduated rectangular stands are crazed. Two-handled soup bowls - 1 stained and crazed, 2 crazed, 1 with repaired handle, 5 ok. Soup saucers - 8 crazed, 11 ok. Dinner plates - 3 crazed and stained, 5 crazed, 8 ok. Teacups - 5 stained and crazed, 1 crazed, 21 ok. Saucers - 1 crazed, 7 ok. Salad plates - 3 crazed, 1 ok. Side plates - 2 discoloured, 5 crazed, 5 ok. Smallest side plates - 1 crazed, 5 ok. Square serving bowl - crazed. Sugar bowl - crazed and with hairline crack. Other bowl - minor crazing. Egg cup tray - crazed. Oval dish - small chip to rim. Salt caster - cracked. Sauce boat - slight crazing. Some light surface scratching to plates/saucers. All Strathmore pattern pieces are crazed, teacup also stained.
