## Condition Report

386. Tray - nice clear hallmarks. One tiny dent to one long edge beneath pierced gallery. One corner ever so slightly misshapen. One foot a tiny bit loose but screws just need tightening. The wood has a white streaked appearance as the varnish has gone removing the patina. Tiny chip to edge of central inlay. Length 45.5cm, width 16cm, height 3.8cm.
