Condition Report

348. Basket - hallmarks rubbed but readable. A few minor dents to reeded decoration but generally in good order. Liner good. Mustard - good clear hallmarks. Cranberry glass liner cracked, otherwise good. Pair casters - hallmarks a teeny bit rubbed. One square base a little misshapen but otherwise ok. Jar - chip to base edge of glass. Hallmarks worn. Spoon - good.
