378. Jug - split to side edge of upper handle terminal. Lower handle terminal pushed in a little. Some dents to body. Maker's mark rubbed otherwise ok. Caster - foot a little pushed up to one side. Typical minor dents to body. Cover quite dented and although has the same part marks could be a match as its fit is questionable.
