A collection of English porcelain plates, late 19th century and later, including a Royal Crown Derby Regency red ground plate, circa 1891, gilt decorated with a basket of flowers and foliate scrolls, diameter 21.5cm, two similar Royal Crown Derby plates, each with foliate gilt and cobalt blue border, and a pair of Grainger & Worcester examples.

## Condition Report

1489. Overall the plates are in good order. Royal Crown Derby red ground plate - some wear to gilt rim, otherwise ok. Pair Grainger's Worcester Floral plates - ok. Royal Crown Derby blue and gilt plate - faint hairline to rim, scratch to centre white area. Doulton Burslem green ground plate - minute and indistinct glaze nick to rim edge. George Jones plate with pink flowers - very light wear but ok. Blue ground Minton - ok. Blue ground Minton with wavy rim - light surface scratches. Copeland with insects - ok. Pierced rim - ok. Gold ground Coalport - ok.
