A collection of English porcelain teacups and saucers, mid-19th century and later, including a Spode cup and saucer, decorated with green and gilt foliate borders, the cup with snake handle, iron red 'Spode 3860' to bases, and a Derby cup and saucer, decorated with a continuous pink and gilt heart shaped border, various marks (some faults).

Estimate: £80 - £120

Condition Report

1486. Green ground Spode - ok. Pink hearts and gilt Derby - very light typical rubbing to rims but ok. Pattern 731 - Derby? - gilt grapes and enamelled flowers. Finely crazed but ok. Worcester with central pink roses - finely crazed but ok. Pattern 7808 - Coalport? - cream ground with flowers. Finely crazed but ok. Turquoise and gilt Davenport - ok. Pattern 3087 - shell detail to rim - crazed with light wear. Gold ground floral decoration - ok. Topographical view - cup crazed with wear and starcrack. Hairline and some stained crazing to saucer. Spode pattern 908 - both cup and saucer repair. Worcester pink ground trio - each piece crazed with some staining. Flight gilding in apricot ground - ok.
