## LOT 1119

A late 19th century French ormolu and porcelain clock garniture, comprising a mantel clock and a pair of urns, the clock with eight day movement striking on a gong, the porcelain dial painted with Roman hour numerals, Cupid, dove, putto and seated shepherdess in a landscape setting, flanked by a pair of landscape panels, the urn surmount above winged caryatid columns and foliate toupie and scroll feet, height 41cm, with pendulum and winding key, flanked by a pair of matching urns, height 34.5cm.

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## Condition Report

1119. A good quality garniture, in good condition with no apparent damage. All porcelain panels are intact and all ormolu is intact. Mechanism appears to be in working order and bears a local restorer's label stating it was fully overhauled in 2012. Good quality Jaby Frères movement. Striking the hours on a gong. Some mounts are a little loose but would only require minor adjustment. The ormolu is in good condition but it is very dirty and would respond well to a good wash. Complete with original pendulum and modern winding key.

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
