An early Victorian and later rosewood and walnut drop dial wall clock with Black Forest eight day twin fusee movement striking on a gong, the painted circular dial with Roman numerals, the octagonal surround with brass inlaid decoration, the apron with glazed lenticle, height 53cm, with pendulum (alterations and restoration).

Estimate: £50 - £80

Condition Report

1095. Case - some signs of springing to the brass inlay. Possibly a new back panel (one securing clip missing). New bezel glass and possibly a repainted dial. Signs of slight damage to lower door hinges and chip/dent in lower base panel. Odd screw in bezel hinge. Glass in viewing panel is insecure. There is no writing, names or labels visible on this clock. The interior retains its original green wash. Movement - appears to be working and striking. Odd screw securing it into the case. Complete with original pendulum.
