A late 19th century brass and pewter cased circular wall clock with eight day movement striking on a gong, the embossed foliate dial with inset enamel hour plaques, the circular brass case applied with pewter foliate scroll mouldings and apron beneath an urn surmount, height 43.5cm (some faults).

Estimate: £50 - £80

Condition Report

1118. This clock is of brass construction with pewter?? (base metal) mounts and its movement forms an integral part of its construction. Without dismantling the case and mechanism it is impossible to report fully on it. There is one very obvious fault - one of the main mounting pieces has been snapped completely off and is totally separated from the clock.
