A mid-18th century French Rococo gold mounted and clear glass scent bottle, the collar enamelled in white and inscribed 'J'aime Mon Choix', the shell shaped detachable stopper fitted with a chain, the mount with overall foliate scrolls and architectural forms, height 6.3cm, within its original shagreen case.

Condition Report

2415. Overall very good original condition, with a very small chip to the enamelled collar just before the 'Jaime'. Also one very small soldered repair to the scrollwork on shoulder of mount. Otherwise the piece is in good crisp order with no apparent damage to the glass or obvious dents to the gold. Some areas of surface dirt. Interior of the case is a little worn and exterior slightly scuffed.

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
