An early 19th century silkwork sampler, finely worked with a pious verse above peacocks, plants and trees, 21cm x 20cm, later framed, together with two other samplers and a Regency floral silkwork (faults).

Estimate: £80 - £120

Condition Report

2807. The first sampler appears to be in fair condition with only some minor fading of colours, just a badly spotted mount. The 'Sarah Bacon 1823' sampler is badly moth damaged particularly with much loss to the centre, also some darker staining to the top. The narrow sampler is a little faded but otherwise reasonable condition. The floral silkwork is quite distressed and shot in areas with some overall staining.

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
