A late 19th century amboyna, ebony banded and porcelain mounted bonheur-du-jour, the galleried top with a central mirrored compartment flanked by doors, each inset with a 'Sèvres' style painted portrait panel, the base fitted with three drawers above two undertiers, on turned legs, height 148cm, width 123cm, depth 55cm.

Condition Report

2138. Some general level of restoration throughout, with some repaired veneer splits to top panel, table top surface and corners of undertier. Some areas of damage to gilt metal trims, including split to gallery and some sections of beading replaced. Drawer is extremely stiff and cannot really pull out, possibly the base board has dropped slightly and will need some attention.
