A Worcester porcelain coffee cup and saucer, circa 1785, of reeded French shape, enamelled with floral garlands beneath a gilt scroll edged cobalt blue rim, workman's marks in underglaze blue to bases, diameter of saucer 13.5cm.

Condition Report

1407. In generally good condition. Both cup and saucer have some minor wear to the gilding on the high points. The cup has a couple of minute nicks to base rim edge, but hardly noticeable. Otherwise no chips, cracks or repairs.
