A Chinese blue and white porcelain double gourd vase, mark of Xuande but Kangxi period, the lower bulb filled with four phoenix medallions, the upper with scattered precious objects and flames, underglaze blue four character mark of Xuande to base, height 17.3cm (reduced neck and applied metal rim).

1010. The neck has been reduced and applied with a metal rim. Two minor chips to footrim, inconsequential. Some typical manufacturers glaze blemishes to body, and light surface scratches to widest part of body.
