A Chinese famille rose export porcelain vase and cover, Qianlong period, painted in the Mandarin palette with opposing figural scenes, height 24cm, together with a Chinese blue and white small jar, height 11cm (damaged neck), and a Chinese blue and white porcelain vase of slender baluster form, height 12cm.

Condition Report

1096. Mandarin palette vase - indistinct hairline to rim and indistinct haircrack to body through lower half of one panel. Restoration to chips on edge of cover and finial. Jar - neck damaged and fitted with replacement metal collar. Hole on shoulders also fitted with metal collar/seal. Vase - in good condition overall, no chips, cracks or repairs.
