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A gold, diamond, pearl and enamel curblink bracelet, the green and white enamelled quatrefoil shaped front mounted with a cushion shaped diamond between red enamelled baton shaped links, spaced with pearls, on a snap clasp, detailed '15', length 18.5cm (some damage to enamel).

Condition Report

675. This piece is possibly a marriage of three different pieces of jewellery. The two row baton link sides may have been part of a single row chain that could have been worn with a fob watch. The hollow curblink sides were probably original part of a plain bracelet. The central green enamelled section might have been the top section of a pendant necklace. There is some damage, particularly to the red enamel of the baton shaped links. The pearls are of a silvery grey colour.

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
