A pair of Chinese sancai glazed porcelain Buddhist lion jostick holders, late 19th century, each modelled seated on a pierced rectangular base, height 15.2cm (repaired), together with two pairs of later sancai glazed Buddhist lions, heights 15.5cm and 13.5cm, and a pair of turquoise glazed Buddhist lions, height 13.5cm.

## Condition Report

1026. Late 19th century pair - one with visibly repaired breaks and some losses to head, missing eyes, chips to raised paw, puzzle ball and scone. Other with some firing cracks to head and body but generally ok. Turquoise pair - couple of minute nicks, generally ok. Pair with yellow bases - one good, other with small chip to base edge and to detail on back and also missing parts of cub. Pair with floral bases - both in good condition overall.
