A large Hispano-Moresque copper and blue lustre two handled vase, 19th century, the amphora shaped body decorated with panels of stylized deer amongst script and floral motifs, with a wrought iron stand, total height 104cm (restored).

Estimate: £300 - £500

Condition Report

1425. Long vertical crack to body running from neck, through middle of 2 deer on one panel, to band of script beneath - some minor filling and losses along the crack, which has some smaller cracks branching from it. Typical wear/rubbing to body where sits in stand. Professional restoration to upper terminal of one handle. Otherwise typical minor glaze frits/chips to some relief detail overall. Some rust to stand, but otherwise ok. Height of vase without stand 72cm.
