A pair of George III Chippendale period mahogany pierced splat back dining chairs with carved strapwork decoration, the drop-in seats raised on chamfered block legs, height 95cm, width 55cm.

Condition Report

2041. Whilst I think the chairs are pre-1800, there is a slight crudity to the workmanship that would suggest they are possibly Colonial. Both are quite solid structurally. The front legs of one of the chairs have been re-tipped with two inches replaced. A few minor repairs to the leg joints but otherwise in fair condition.
