A pair of Jean Gille of Paris bisque porcelain figures, late 19th century, each modelled wearing 18th century dress, one as a lady applying flowers to her hair, the other as a seated gentleman holding up a mirror, blue applied mark to bases, heights 16.5cm and 17cm, together with three similar bisque porcelain figures, each in 18th century dress (minor faults).

## Condition Report

1471. Girl adjusting rose in hair - firing crack to front of neck which has some filling, another firing crack to lower left arm and right wrist, right little finger restored. Boy holding mirror - tiny nick to corner of mirror, otherwise ok. Girl with basket - basket and left arm both poorly restored, chip to bonnet. Gallant holding hat - missing what would have been in right hand. Gallant wearing hat - chip to inner edge of base, left toes restored, minute nick to hat and tips of left fingers.
