A pair of Chinese Canton export watercolours on rice paper, mid/late 19th century, each depicting figural scenes, $20 \text{cm} \times 32 \text{cm}$, framed and glazed, together with a Tibetan thangka, painted with Buddhistic deities and central star motif, $28.5 \text{cm} \times 21 \text{cm}$, framed and glazed.

Condition Report

1075. Interior watercolour - long tear to bottom edge in middle and similar tear to bottom right corner - secured with border tape and neither interfere with the main panel as outside the perimeter black line, otherwise ok. Slight discolouration/blemish running horizontally through middle. Exterior watercolour - similar long tears to middle of bottom edge, both bottom corners, top right corner and middle of top edge. All outside of black perimeter. Slight discolouration running horizontally through middle. Thangka - in good order.
